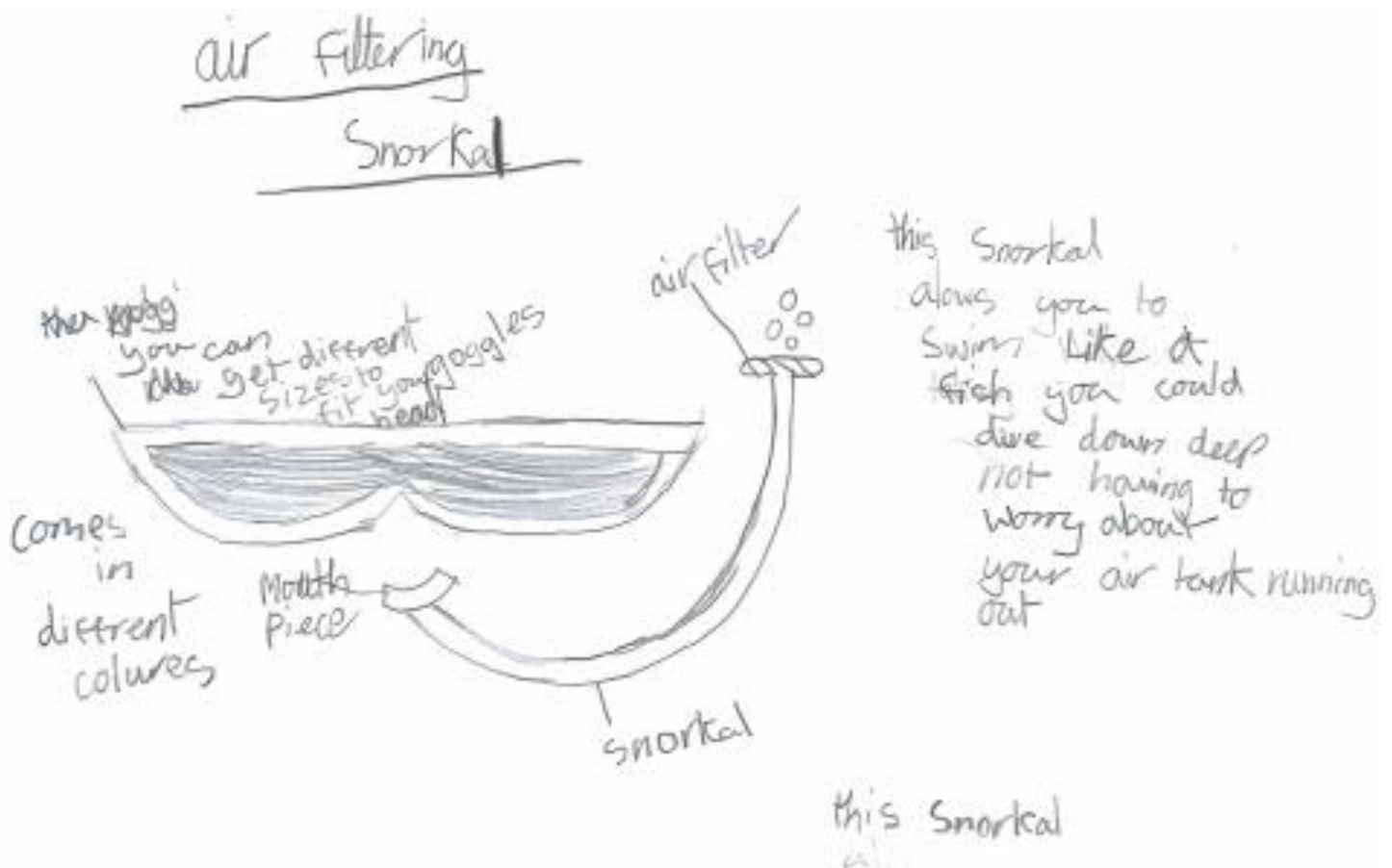
3rd - Find My Pet Collar by Katie. I love the idea of the GPS map and also the camera so you have your cat's view of the world!

THE PLASTIC O-MATRIC!

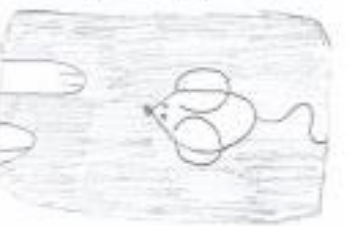
The plastic O-matric automatically O-matric picks up unrecycled plastic on beaches! The original O-matric was to do a plastic O-matric and it does everything for you!

The children made some fabulous creations using Lego and blocks this week showing great building and teamwork skills. Photos of these have been added to the children's individual Class Dojo profiles.

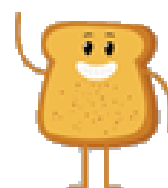

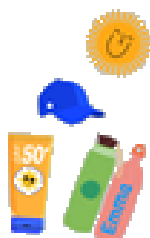
