

Volunteer Cornwall are co-ordinating a volunteer response to Coronavirus. The main aim is to provide support to people in the community – particularly older or vulnerable residents – who have to self-isolate either because they, or someone they have come into contact with, has (or is suspected to have) the virus. For many people, 2 weeks of self isolation will leave them in a position of risk because they haven't got social networks (friends, relatives or neighbours) who can help them. 
We are now taking bookings for Easter. We are open between 7.45am and 6pm. Book now through School gateway.




