For many people, 2 weeks of self isolation will leave them in a position of risk because they haven't got social networks (friends, relatives or neighbours) who can help them. 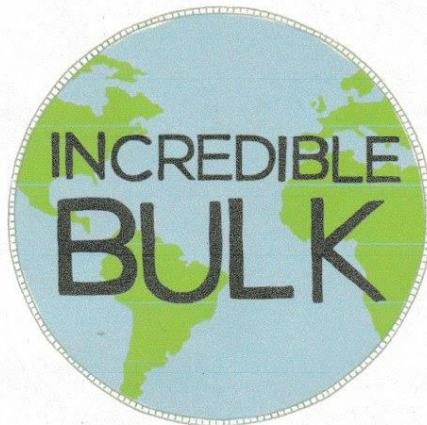
