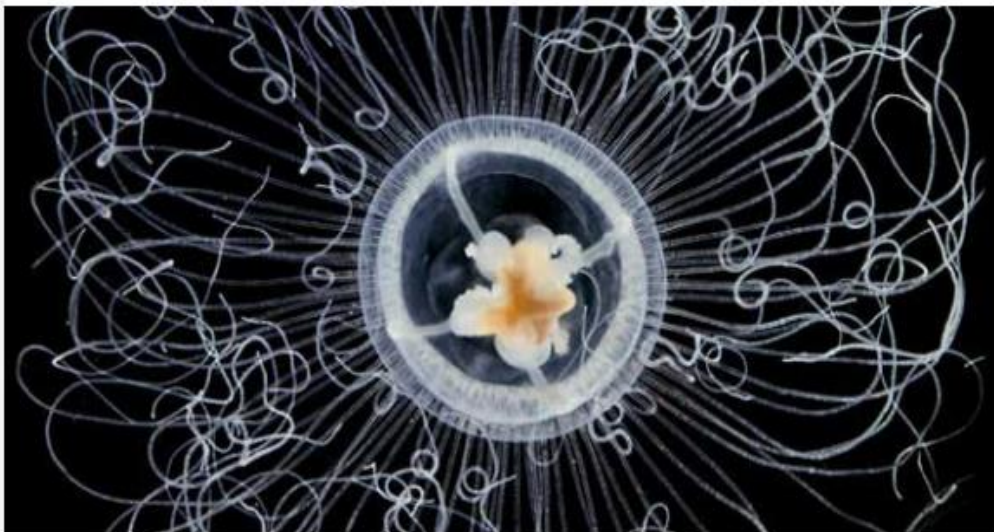
## Experience fascinating new art and artistry

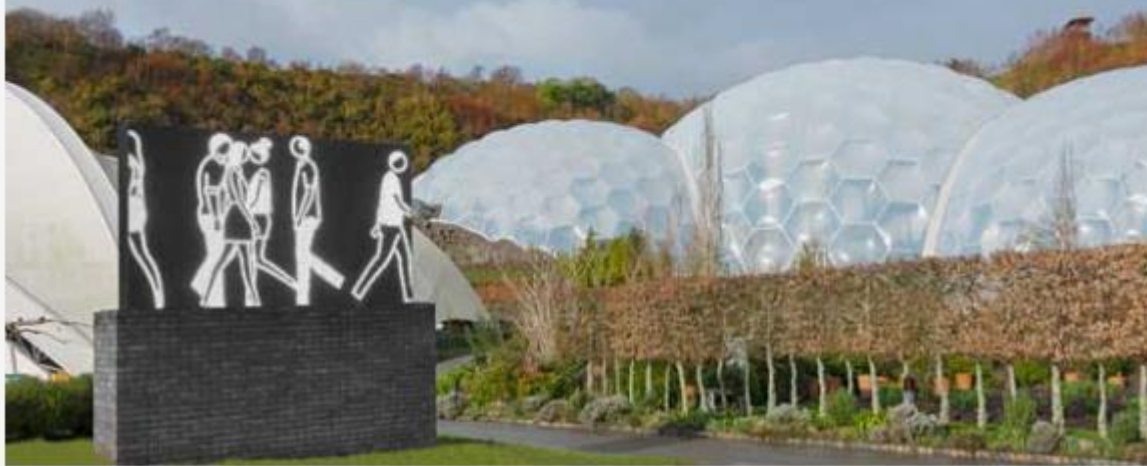
### Discover the invisible depths of the ocean

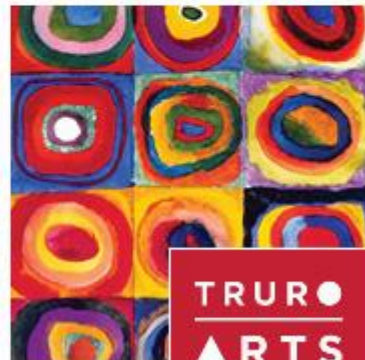


### MAGNIFICENT MOBILES
