Monday 4th March 10am - 4pm £50

This workshop is a fun, right-brain stimulating exploration of the style and techniques of Vincent van Gogh and is open to all levels of artist from professional to complete beginner. You will look at some reproductions of Van Gogh's works and Sarah will demonstrate some of his techniques before you either create your own version of your choice of his paintings or use his style to paint an image of your own.

Sarah is a professional artist and illustrator, the only English artist-animator to work on the film 'Loving Vincent' and an expert in the style of van Gogh. She has exhibited with the Sunday Times Watercolour Competition, The Discerning Eye, the RI as well as solo shows.


