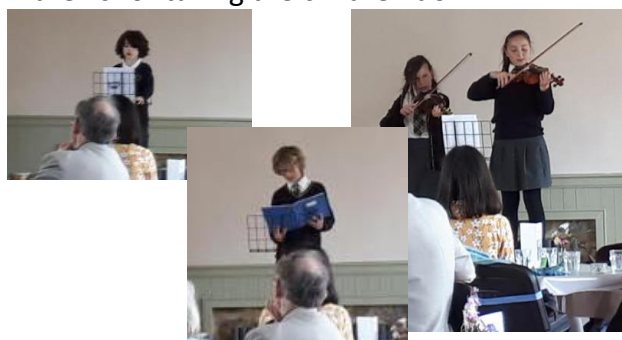

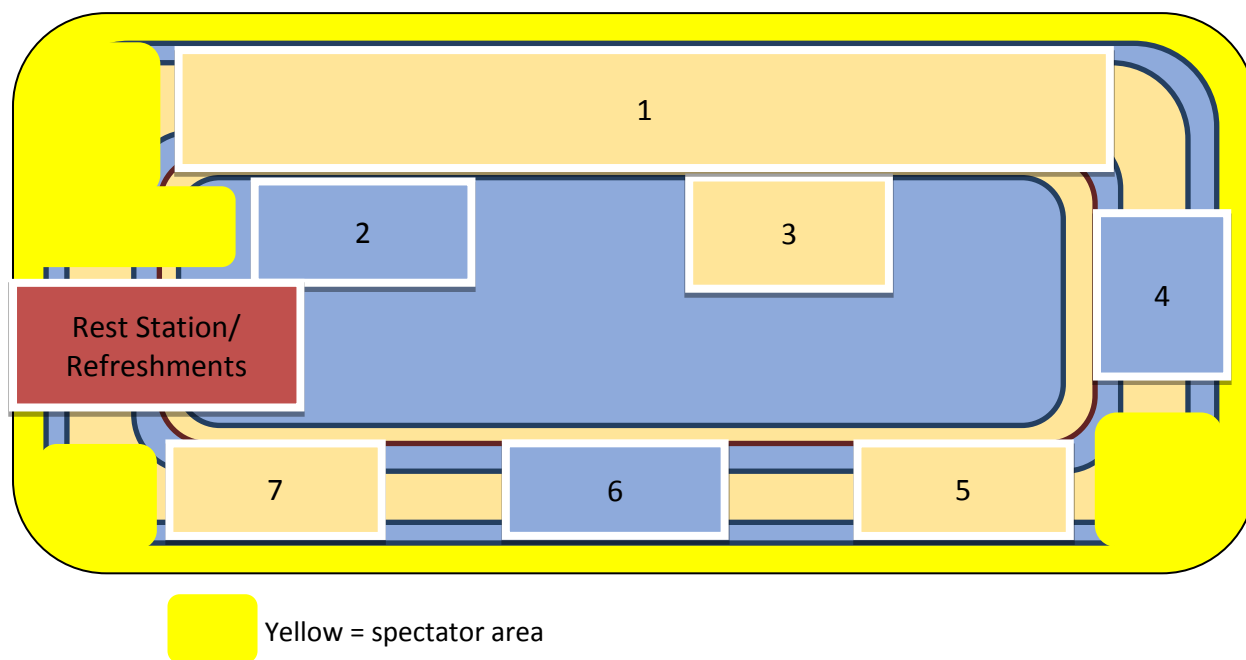
There will be 7 activities and a rest station for refreshments.
