Seven activities and a rest station for refreshments.

There will be Seven groups (each class will be a group).

Each activity will involve four teams (Longships, Pendeen, Trevose, Godrevy



3 points for second placed team.

Sprint race.

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* ☆ Equipment: Straight section of running track- Fdn-30m KS1-40-50m KS2- 60-80m & Stickers.

(2) Egg & Spoon Race. (moving in and out of the cones)

Equipment: 4 x eggs & spoons 16 x cones.

(3) KS2 Three Legged race.

Equipment: 4 x straps & 4 x cones

KS1 Skipping (Skipping out to a cone and then running back carrying the rope to the next person).

Equipment: 4 x skipping ropes & 4 x cones

FS Hopscotch (out to a cone and then running back to the next person).

Equipment: 24 x spots & 4 x cones

(4) Ball skills (dribbling in and out of 5 cones then shooting).

5 cones per team, 1 football per team & 2 x goals. Equipment:

(5) Javelin


Equipment: 4-8 Javelins, 12 x cones

(6) Obstacle Relay (each team to be split to stand at opposite sides of the area)

4 x hula hoops, 1 x parachute, 4 x tyres 4 x tennis rackets & balls & 8 x cones

(7) Gymnastics (1 x roll, bunny hop along bench, skip out to cone & run back)

4 x gym mats, 4 x benches 8 x cones



Families of children (the spectators) will be allowed to watch their children participate but must be kept a safe distance away from the activities so as to not disturb the races/games.

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After all the races have been completed their will be a toddlers' race and a Parents'/Carers' race, which will take place in AREA 1.

The Toddlers' race- sprint of a distance of 10 metres.

Parents' Race- Bean bag balanced on the head carrying 'egg & spoon'
