

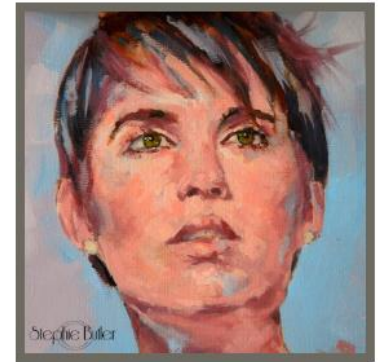

Truro Arts are very excited to be able to introduce you to some new workshop tutors who will be joining our existing bunch of talented artists. The first of our guest tutors to be announced is Stephie Butler, who will be travelling down to join us on Wednesday 1st May to run a watercolour workshop. Her work has featured in numerous watercolour technique books, she tutors internationally and her work is in private collections across the world. Stephie is an elected member of the Society of Women Artists, and she regularly exhibits in the prestigious Mall Galleries in London. This is a great opportunity to be taught by an internationally acclaimed artist and tutor. Spaces are going fast, so book soon to avoid disappointment!



In this exciting, informative workshop, Stephie will show you how to paint portraits in watercolour that are full of colour with an impressionistic feel, making your works unique. There will be a mixture of ongoing demonstrating and one-to-one attention that will focus on the face and how to portray feelings and emotion in a subject. You will be encouraged to develop your own style, to learn how to paint with instinct alongside technique, to simplify drawings prior to painting to enable a looser style, to paint with colour that deviates away from the norm. Most of all, you'll have fun and come away inspired to paint more!

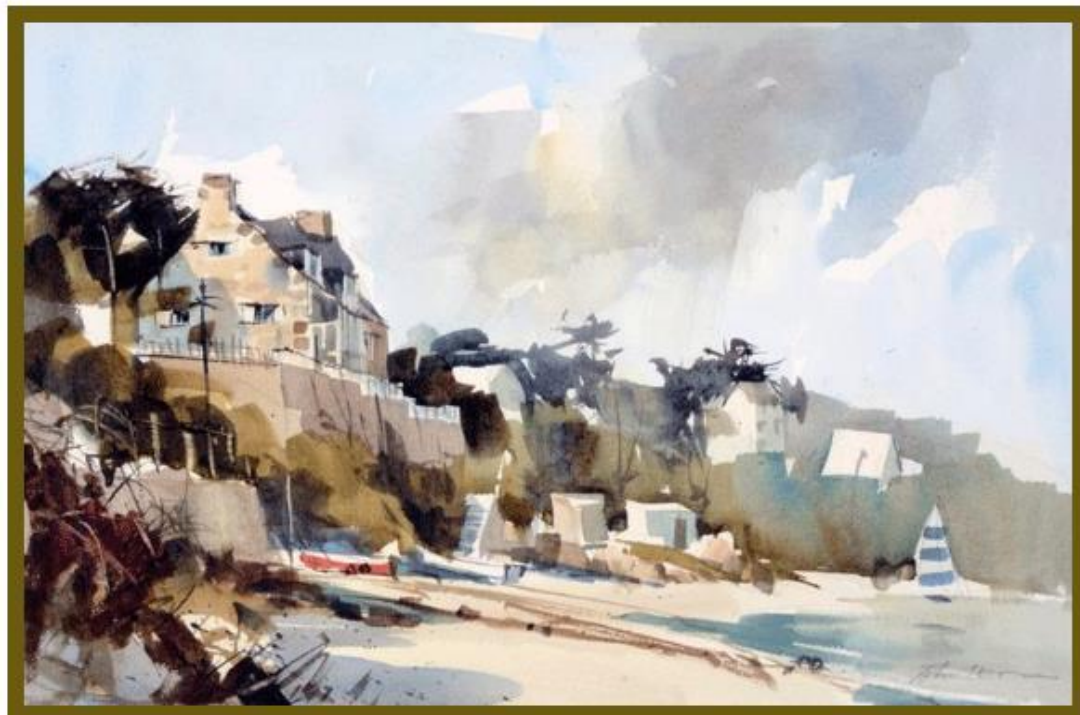

## Fast and Free Watercolours

with John Hoar



We are very pleased to announce that the hugely talented John Hoar will be joining us to run a workshop on Monday 17th June. Considered to be one of the best watercolourists in the country, he is the master of fast-flowing washes and impressionistic watercolour landscapes.

Using pen and wash, and a limited palette, John will show you how to create an exciting painting that crackles with energy – painted in his own inimitable style. He will reveal how to distil an often complex scene into a simplified watercolour masterpiece. The workshop will be about making free and competent watercolours, using lots of water and understanding the importance of tone. You will complete three paintings, one of which will be with pen and ink and wash.

One of the most gifted watercolour artists in Britain today, John read Architecture at Cambridge and studied drawing and painting under Ruskin Spear R.A. He began painting full time in 1980, specialising in architectural subjects, landscapes and marine and floral studies. He has had over 50 one-man shows in England and Ireland, his latest being in China in 2016 where he represented Britain at the 2nd International Watercolour Salon at Qingdao. He is well-known for his instructional DVDs - five of which have been produced by Town House Films - which aim to teach aspiring artists how to paint simple and vibrant watercolours. He is an inspiring teacher, much in demand, who directs several residential courses both in Ireland and the UK and holds regular workshops at his home in South Molton, Devon.

John has his own gallery in his home town and holds two exhibitions a year as well as displaying work in galleries in England and Ireland. John has won a number of prestigious painting awards, including the Donald Blake prize in 2003, and the Lincoln Joyce prize at the Royal Institute of Painters in Watercolour.
