### **United Downs Deep Geothermal Power Project Drop-In on Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> June 2019 11am – 1pm \*\*\* Last chance to see the drilling rig \*\*\***

There is another opportunity to visit the United Downs Deep Geothermal Power (UDDGP) project site on Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> June any time between 11am - 1pm. This will be the last opportunity to view the drilling rig before it is removed from the site. There will be members of the project team to talk to, information panels to browse, educational and project films to watch, get up close to some of the used drill bits and view the 52m high drilling rig from the viewing platform.

**Drop-In sessions are free** and suitable for all the family with colouring pages and an interesting facts trail. Under 18s must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times. Visitor access is on foot through gate B behind County Tyres. There is no public parking at the project site. 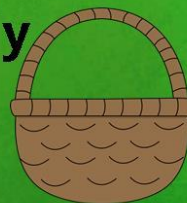

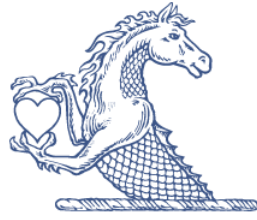

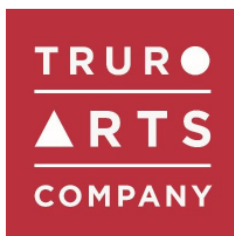
Join us for an evening of alfresco Opera in our gardens, Sunday 30th June. Performance commences at 7pm

\*An indoor wet weather plan is in place, in case of inclement weather ... the performance will go ahead regardless!

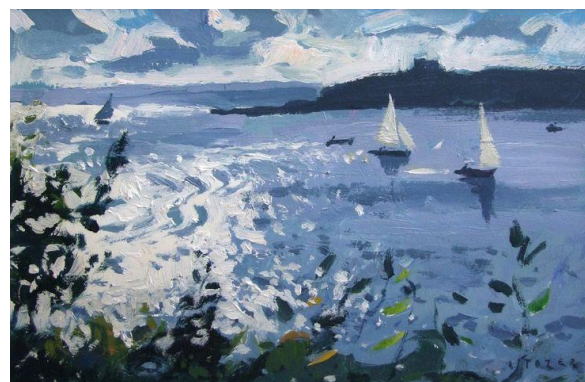
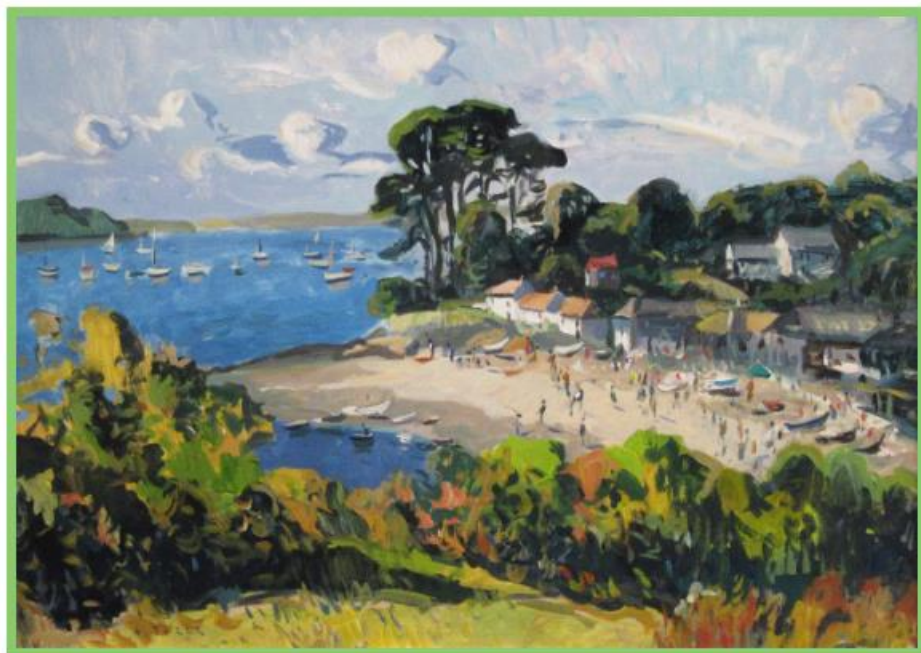




## Capturing Light and Shade

Be inspired by Andrew's impressionistic style and carefully selected colour palette whilst bringing your painting to life. Learn how Andrew uses rigorous draftsmanship and intensity and complexity of paint handling to create the effects of simplicity and beauty in his work. Andrew incorporates fantastic use of light and depth into his paintings – be prepared to surprise yourself and come away feeling fully inspired.

Andrew Tozer is one of the leading contemporary painters in whose work the legacy of Impressionism resonates: Andrew captures light, atmosphere, and the very essence of his subject matter in paintings that manage to conjure memories of the past whilst being firmly in the present. His work is celebratory with a dreamlike quality evoking memories of place and time. Andrew chooses simple and joyful subjects which move him; boats at rest in a harbour, a figure in the quiet of the studio or precious family moments. His work contains a vibrant sense of movement and a powerful energy. Andrew is a passionate advocate of acrylic paint, using the medium for his en plein air and studio work. Andrew has had numerous solo exhibitions, has exhibited at the prestigious Mall Galleries, London, and his work is collected internationally.
