Thanks to support from the National Lottery Heritage Fund, Hall For Cornwall have been delivering a huge activity plan of workshops, performances, talks & tours, to tell the story of the building as it is undergoing another major transformation.

In partnership with KEAP and The Writers' Block they have gathered stories with schools and community groups

Children from Truro Learning Academy, Bosvigo, St Mary's and Richard Lander schools have been heritage detectives, digging deep into the history to find out about quirky shows and events that have taken place, as well as more sober stories from 'Under the Clock. This building has seen some incredible things.

These hidden tales have been revealed through stories and poems created by the schools and local writers. They will be celebrated through an evening of sharing and a day of trails animated by The Story Republicans. Encounter the burning clock and escaping bulls, romantic dances and the magistrate's gavel.


