Soccer Aid for UNICEF 2022 is just around the corner and we're really excited to be getting involved this year with our very own Soccer Aid Schools Challenge! This is a great opportunity to have fun, play and get the whole school together after two years of distance and disruption. Through the Schools Challenge, our pupils will learn about and raise money for children everywhere to help give them a childhood full of play.

What are we doing?

To raise money, on Friday 17th June, we will be inviting children to come to school in sports kit for a donation of £1, each class will take part in a football obstacle course throughout the day. After school, children and adults will have the opportunity to take part in a 'Beat the Teacher Penalty Shootout' outside Year 6. We are asking for donations of £1 for 3 penalties all going towards this important cause.

How can you help?

We would love to invite you to join in the fun! In return for a small donation, children, staff and parents will all be able to take part in a thoroughly enjoyable event, whilst making a difference to children's lives around the world.

Why are we doing it?

Childhood should be one endless playtime. But around the world, disease, hunger, conflict, poverty and disaster are disrupting play for millions of kids. The money we raise can help provide clean water and vaccines, education and protection from violence so that children can grow up happy, healthy and able to play. Just like children should.

Just £6 could buy a large plastic brick to help build a classroom in Cote D'Ivoire. Just £30 could provide an emergency shelter kit to help protect children forced from their homes. We have set a target of raising £350 which is enough to fund a water pump for a community in a developing country.

We really appreciate your support and hope that you will join us to play, fundraise and change children's lives.
