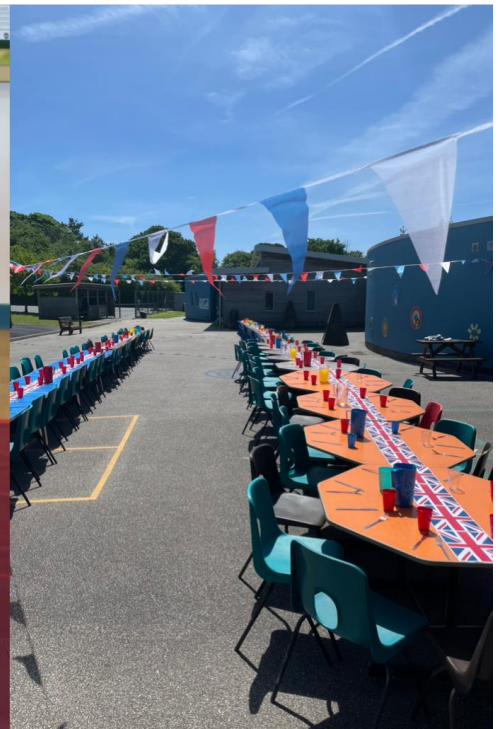
Park Run at Trelissick
