At some point during 2020 perhaps some of your neighbours may be required to self-isolate due to COVID-19. You may have seen, reported by mainstream media organisations, that Becky Wass from Falmouth has designed a postcard aimed at helping people to look after their neighbours if they are self-isolating.

The print-at-home template printable pdf (bit.lv/viralkindness) is being shared to enable people to share their contact details with their neighbours, so that they may request shopping, urgent supplies or a friendly phone call, in the event of being required to self-isolate.


