This year, we are going to dress up for World Book Day, but with a twist!

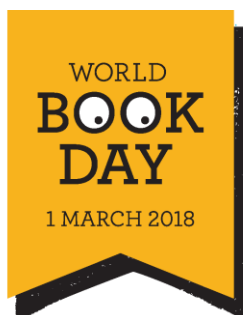
The theme this year is:
