Light and Movement in Watercolour



with Jake Winkle

Award-winning artist Jake Winkle is inspired by light and movement, and his paintings are a reflection of the world around him. During this workshop, Jake will show you how to paint bold, loose watercolours using fabulous colour and expressive brush strokes. Sharing his expertise, he will guide you through steps to complete two paintings. You will learn various skills including mark-making techniques, wet on wet, and dry brush.

Jake exhibits widely in the south of England and in 2004 was a finalist in the Dail Mail's 'Not The Turner Prize' competition. In 2007 his work was selected for the Royal Society of British Artist's exhibition in The Mall Galleries, London, and from that time he has been contributing regular articles about his painting style to The Artist magazine. Jake has been winner of category and best in show at Marwell International Wildlife Art Society's annual exhibition and in 2009 was awarded the prestigious St. Cuthberts Mill award for best watercolour at the Society of Equestrian Artist's annual show.



As well as exhibitions in London and the south of England, Jake has undertaken many fine art commissions for individuals and notable organisations including The National Trust.



Illustrative Acrylic Painting

with Sophie Harding



Monday 19th August 10am - 4pm £50

Sophie Harding is renowned for her bold, distinctive artwork, and in this workshop, she will show examples of her style, then demonstrate how to create a really strong illustrative image. Students will be shown techniques in colour mixing, will experiment with the opacity of paint, and be shown how to achieve different effects with acrylics. The morning will be spent developing sketch ideas into designs from either photos or sketchbook drawings, which will then be painted up in the afternoon, to produce two co-ordinating illustrations suitable for card designs.



Sophie has worked as an artist, illustrator and textile designer for 25 years, as well as being represented in galleries such as Gallery Tresco and Ainscough Contemporary Art. Sophie's clients have included Marks and Spencers, Artists Cards Ltd. and Woolworths.
