

This practical painting workshop (with gouache paints provided) will enable you to develop an understanding of colour contrast. It is based on the visual experience of seeing and making colour, and will provide a complete introduction to the use of the colour wheel followed by a practical painting workshop. Your work will be done at a small scale using gouache paint on paper (the ideal paint choice for painting exercises due to its opacity), before being developed into final collages. Mary will share her wealth of experience and knowledge to ensure you go away with a deeper understanding of colour that allows you to paint with confidence.
