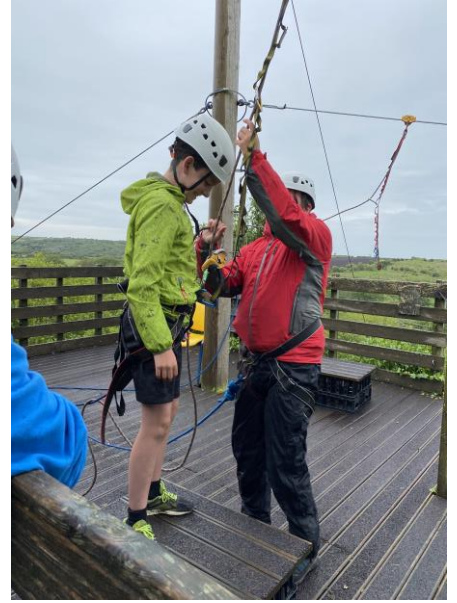
### Truro Foodbank Support
