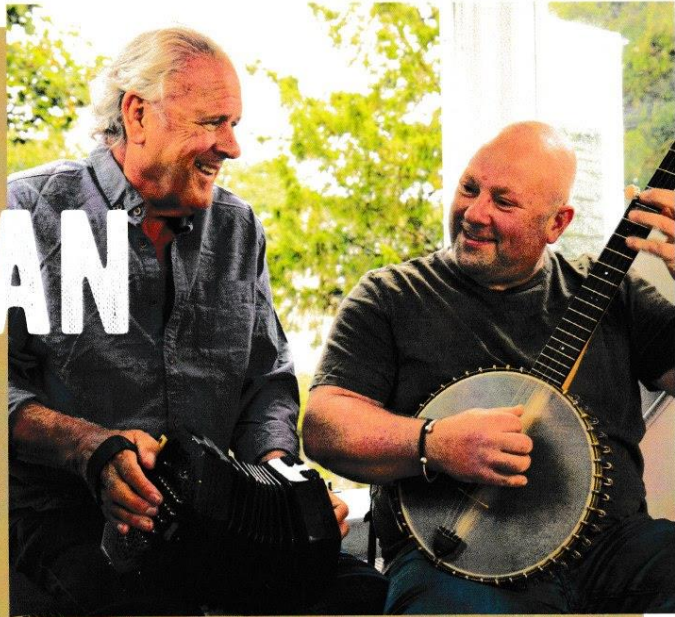
Join Lisa from Down by the River Florals to create a fresh foliage wreath!

# GEOFF LAKEMAN & ROB MURCH



**THE "TITAN OF TWANG" AND THE "CONCERTINA CROONER" TEAM UP IN A DYNAMIC NEW FOLK/ACOUSTIC DUO.**

**GEOFF LAKEMAN**, patriarch of a folk dynasty - as dad of Seth, Sean and Sam and father-in-law of Cara Dillon and Kathryn Roberts - teases English and Irish folk, Americana and jazz songs out of his vintage duet concertina.

**ROB MURCH** brings the wow factor to the banjo, with his unique, punchy fingerstyle playing.

Both live on Dartmoor, so it was inevitable they'd gang-up musically. Expect self-written and West Country songs, rattling folk tunes and foot-stomping ragtime and cakewalk riffs.

Rob's percussive finger-ballet up and down the fret board of his 100 year-old instrument is mesmerising. He's revered throughout the UK for his long-time work with the renowned Dartmoor Pixie Band and The Watch trio.

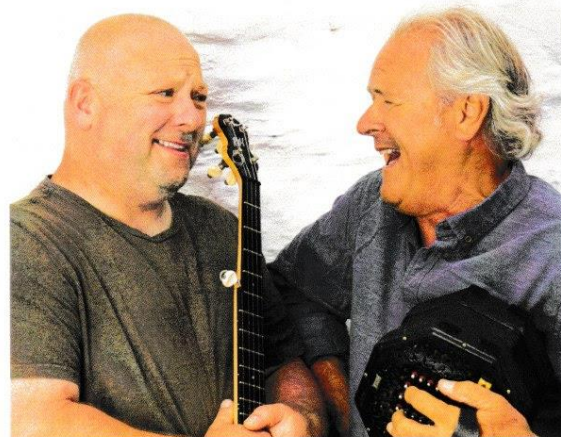
After 50 years as a journalist, music-loving Geoff recorded his debut CD, *After All These Years* at the age of 69, which garnered four and five-star reviews and national radio airplay. He's acclaimed for his "masterful" playing of the rare Crane duet concertina and his "rich, melodic voice."

The duo's relaxed yet sparkling stage presence together is bubbling with the "feel-good" factor.

Between them Geoff and Rob have performed at festivals all over the UK and abroad, theatres, arts centres and folks clubs. They are equally at ease in venues large or small.

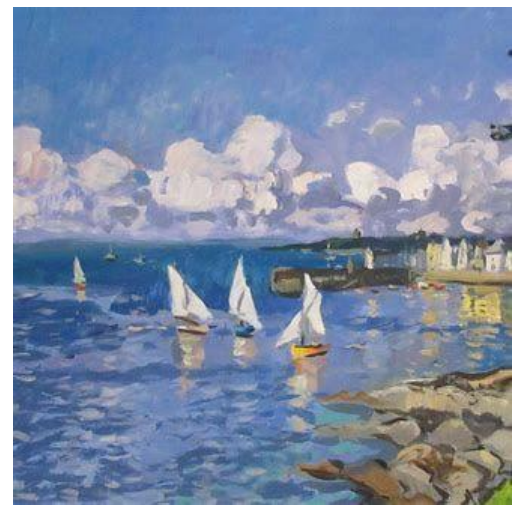
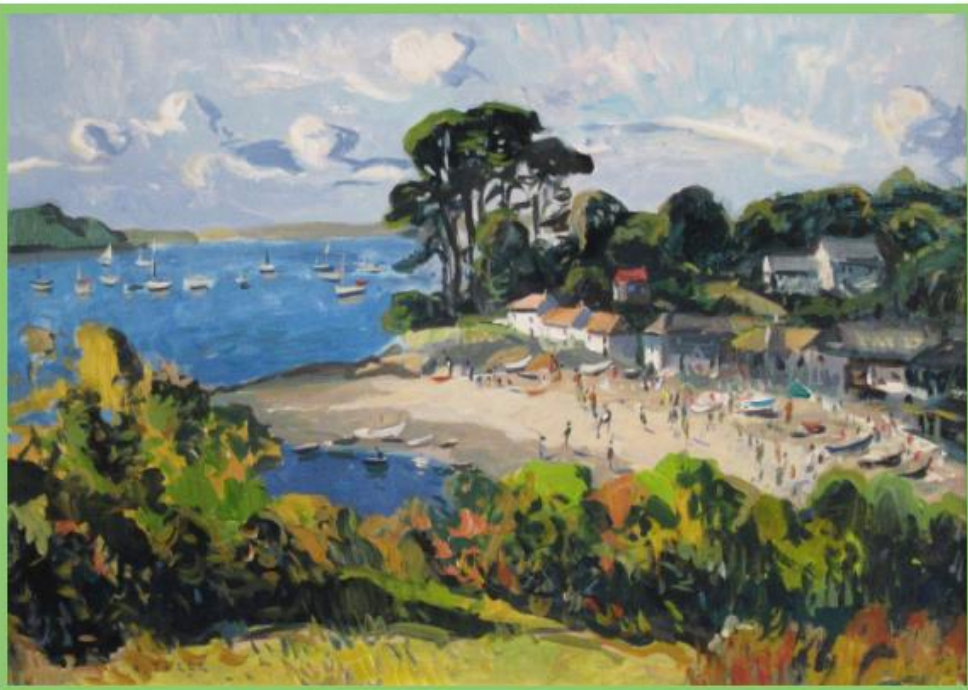

with Andrew Tozer

Spend the day learning how to capture the essence of Cornwall's dramatic and ever-changing coastline. Be inspired by Andrew's impressionistic style and carefully selected colour palette whilst bringing your painting to life. Learn how Andrew uses rigorous draftsmanship and intensity and complexity of paint handling to create the effects of simplicity and beauty in his work. Andrew incorporates fantastic use of light and depth into his paintings – be prepared to surprise yourself and come away feeling fully inspired.

Andrew Tozer is one of the leading contemporary painters in whose work the legacy of Impressionism resonates: Andrew captures light, atmosphere, and the very essence of his subject matter in paintings that manage to conjure memories of the past whilst being firmly in the present. His work is celebratory with a dreamlike quality evoking memories of place and time. Andrew chooses simple and joyful subjects which move him; boats at rest in a harbour, a figure in the quiet of the studio or precious family moments. His work contains a vibrant sense of movement and a powerful energy. Andrew is a passionate advocate of acrylic paint, using the medium for his en plein air and studio work. Andrew has had numerous solo exhibitions, has exhibited at the prestigious Mall Galleries, London, and his work is collected internationally.
