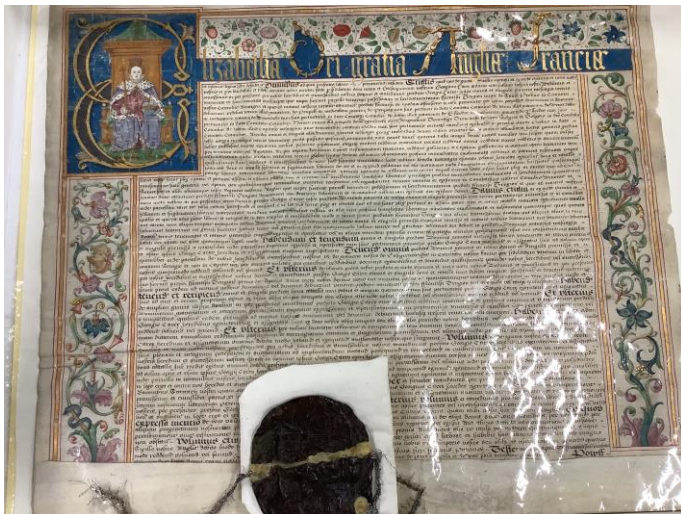
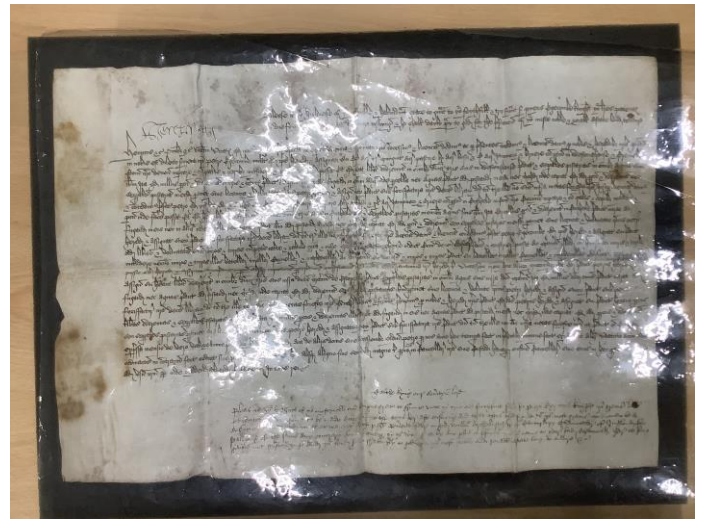


Primary School Show Jumping Competition and Gymkhana
